For many months our missional network has been dreaming of **Crossroads Connection**, a ministry focused on connecting neighbors for a stronger and more compassionate community. We already have many partners, including Richfield UMC who has offered their building as a community center, the Uwharrie District who has funded programming and a part time coordinator, Jennifer Orr, for the past 6 months. Now we have a new partner in the **Duke Endowment!**

The Duke Endowment strengthens communities in North Carolina by nurturing children, promoting health, educating minds and enriching spirits. They have awarded a \$200,000 grant to our missional network to help us follow God into a new ministry for our community! Disbursed over three years, these grant monies will help fund salary for a coordinator, breaking ground on renovations to the community center space at Richfield UMC, and for programming.
